<u>Naval aces P 35</u> (24 May 17) Naval 8 had a rematch with Jasta 11 over Douai the next morning, during which Booker claimed a D III in flames and shared 2 others with Flt Sub Lt McDonald from St Joseph's Nova Scotia. These coincided with Jasta 11's losses of Ltn Hintsch, who was killed and Ltn Willhelm Allmenroder, wounded, but Ltn Otto Masshof shot down Flt Sub Lt H L Smith. (Hintsch shot down Pailthorpe the previous day)
